

Processing instructions
BAG round shutterings Ø 150 mm to 600 mm for the
subsequent concreting of existing columns

Round shutterings for subsequent concreting around existing columns are opened lengthwise. The shutterings are opened far enough on site to be able to place them around the existing column.

The shuttering joints are then fixed to each other with the help of glass fibre reinforced adhesive tape (w = 50 mm).

The fixings are applied at distances of 150 mm from top to bottom.

Subsequently, the shuttering is wound with glass fibre reinforced adhesive tape (w = 150 mm, alternatively 50 mm) from bottom to top and from top to bottom.

Make sure here that the individual turns overlap by at least 15 mm.

The shutterings are to be aligned and fixed at the bottom and top by the customer before concreting.
